Dam Safety Facts

The OWRB Dam Safety Program regulates more than 4,700 non-federal dams.



The average age of all dams in the U.S. is more than 53 years old.



These dams provide numerous benefits, including downstream flood reduction, drinking and irrigation water, recreational opportunities, and increased property values.



Oftentimes these dams are owned by HOAs or private individuals, who are responsible for the periodic inspection, maintenance, and safety of the dam.

How do I know if I live near a dam?
