## *Helping Oklahomans Build Oklahoma's Future*

### **Programmatic Restrictions**

- \$500,000 maximum per project per applicant
- Projects must demonstrate water efficiency and support drought resiliency
- Application must be received by the OWRB no later than 11:00 a.m. on November 26, 2014

### **Eligible Entities**

- Counties
- Towns and municipalities
- Public Works Authorities
- School districts
- Districts formed under Title 82 of the State's statutes as follows:
  - Rural water districts
  - Water conservancy districts
  - Rural sewage districts
  - Irrigation districts

### **Eligible Projects**

- Water efficient devices in public buildings
- Automatic water meters
- Leak detection and associated repairs within distribution systems
- Water audit and water conservation plans
- Recycling and water reuse to replace potable sources with non-potable sources
- Public landscape irrigation systems
- Public irrigation systems

Projects to be considered for this grant funding must demonstrate water efficiency and support drought resiliency within the community or water/wastewater system. ***Water efficiency is defined as the use of improved technologies and practices to deliver equal or better services with less water. Water efficiency encompasses conservation and reuse efforts, as well as water loss reduction and prevention, to protect water resources for the future.***

A project may include any of the previously listed categories or a combination thereof. ***Eligible costs include costs for planning, design, construction, inspection, and testing. Documentation of the percent efficiency to be achieved with the eligible project must be included in the planning document.*** The percentage of efficiency will be calculated by determining percent change between current and proposed water usage.
