Revision of FY 2008 Intended Use Plan and Project Priority List

In accordance with program regulations, the FY 2008 Clean Water SRF Intended Use Plan (IUP), a strategic plan outlining the program's financial and pollution control goals and activities for FY 2008, is being amended to add one wastewater construction project and remove two wastewater construction projects. These projects were proposed following the public meeting, held June 21, 2007 and the subsequent approval of the draft FY 2008 IUP.

The FY 2008 CWSRF Project Priority List has been revised to reflect these changes (attached). Eligibility requirements for CWSRF projects are identified in Section 212 of the Federal Clean Water Act and Oklahoma Water Resources Board CWSRF program administration rules. Other CWSRF loan projects anticipating funding during FY 2008 will not be adversely affected by these amendments.

Priority List Revisions

Grove Municipal Services Authority - The Authority submitted a letter, dated November 6, 2007, requesting financing through the CWSRF in the amount of \$1.9 million for a Wastewater Treatment Plant improvements project. Proposed OWRB approval and construction start dates are 05/13/08 and 07/13/08, respectively.

City of Spencer— The City of Spencer submitted a letter, dated August 23, 2007, requesting removal from the Project Priority list.

Town of Kellyville – The Town of Kellyville submitted a letter, dated December 10, 2007, notifying the OWRB that CWSRF funds are no longer needed for a Sewer System Evaluation Survey.

Other changes— Several entities with projects listed on the FY 08 CWSRF Priority List have requested changes due to revised project items or construction estimates and/or target project approval dates. The list has been revised to reflect these adjustments. Total funds required for projects listed on the FY 2008 list have increased by approximately \$3.75 million, to \$93,204,660.

Public Notice

This amendment is being made with adequate public notice in accordance with the procedures provided in 40 CFR Part 35 Subpart K Paragraph 35.3150(c) and Chapter 50, Part 3 of the OWRB CWSRF Regulations. The OWRB issued a press release, on January 17, 2008 to print media statewide, posted notice, along with a summary of the amendment, entitled FY 2008 IUP Amendment No. 1, on the OWRB website, and distributed announcements to public wastewater authorities currently listed on the IUP, state and federal agencies, and other stakeholders.
