Eligible Entities

- Counties, towns, and municipalities
- Public Works Authorities
- School districts
- Districts formed under Title 82 of the State's statutes as follows:
 - Water conservancy districts
 - Rural water districts
 - Irrigation districts

Eligible Projects

- Drinking water treatment
- New intake/raw water lines
- Major distribution/storage system rehabilitation
- New storage
- Engineering
- New transmission/distribution systems

Program Requirements

- Projects must be listed on the DWSRF
 Project Priority List and current Intended
 Use Plan maintained by the Department of
 Environmental Quality (DEQ). Projects that
 are ready to proceed will receive the highest priority.
- Engineering report as required by the DEQ, including a cost-effective analysis
- Sufficient economic and environmental information for the DEQ to issue an environmental decision regarding project impacts



Program Requirements (continued)

- Public participation/public hearing with public notice
- Project will be required to comply with federal Safe Drinking Water Act requirements and federal cross-cutting laws and authorities.

DWSRF Loan Terms

- Interest Rate: Approximately 70% of AAA market rate with 30% savings through interest subsidy
- 0.50% Administration Fee
- Up to 30-year term
- 1.25x Debt Coverage Ratio Requirement
- No Cash Reserve Requirement
- No interest charged on unused loan portion
