


Simple Map Viewer - Help Guide

MAP LAYERS

CHANGE THE MAP LAYERS:

Click the “Layers” menu to turn on and off map layers.


Check the box next to the layer’s name to turn it on and off



CHANGE THE BACKGROUND MAP:

Click the “Background Image” menu to change the map background.

Click the thumbnail images to switch backgrounds



MAP INFORMATION


LEGEND AND DETAILS

The “**Legend**” and “**Detail**” buttons let you toggle between the map legend and detail information about the map.



FEATURE IDENTIFICATION:

Click on a map feature to open the information window.



MEASURE AND LOCATION TOOLS:


The measure tools can be used to measure the distance between two points or along a line, to measure the area of a polygon that you define, or to return the longitude and latitude of a point where you click.



MAP NAVIGATION


BASIC NAVIGATION:

There are several ways to navigate the map and find the feature or place of your interest.



SEARCH BY ADDRESS OR PLACE NAME:

You can type in address or place name in the search box to zoom directly to the feature.



ZOOM TO FEATURES:

Use the "Zoom to Features" menu to select and to zoom directly to a county.
