I have been following the studies done on the Arbuckle Simpson aquifer and Senate Bill 288 since they first began and have been impressed with the amount of work and the sound science that was used to determine the maximum annual yield (MAY). I believe an equal proportionate share (EPS) of 0.2 ac-ft/ac will be protective of the springs and streams in the area. This area depends a great deal on tourism and the springs and streams are integral to tourism. Sustainability of these natural resources is essential for continued economic growth for this area.
