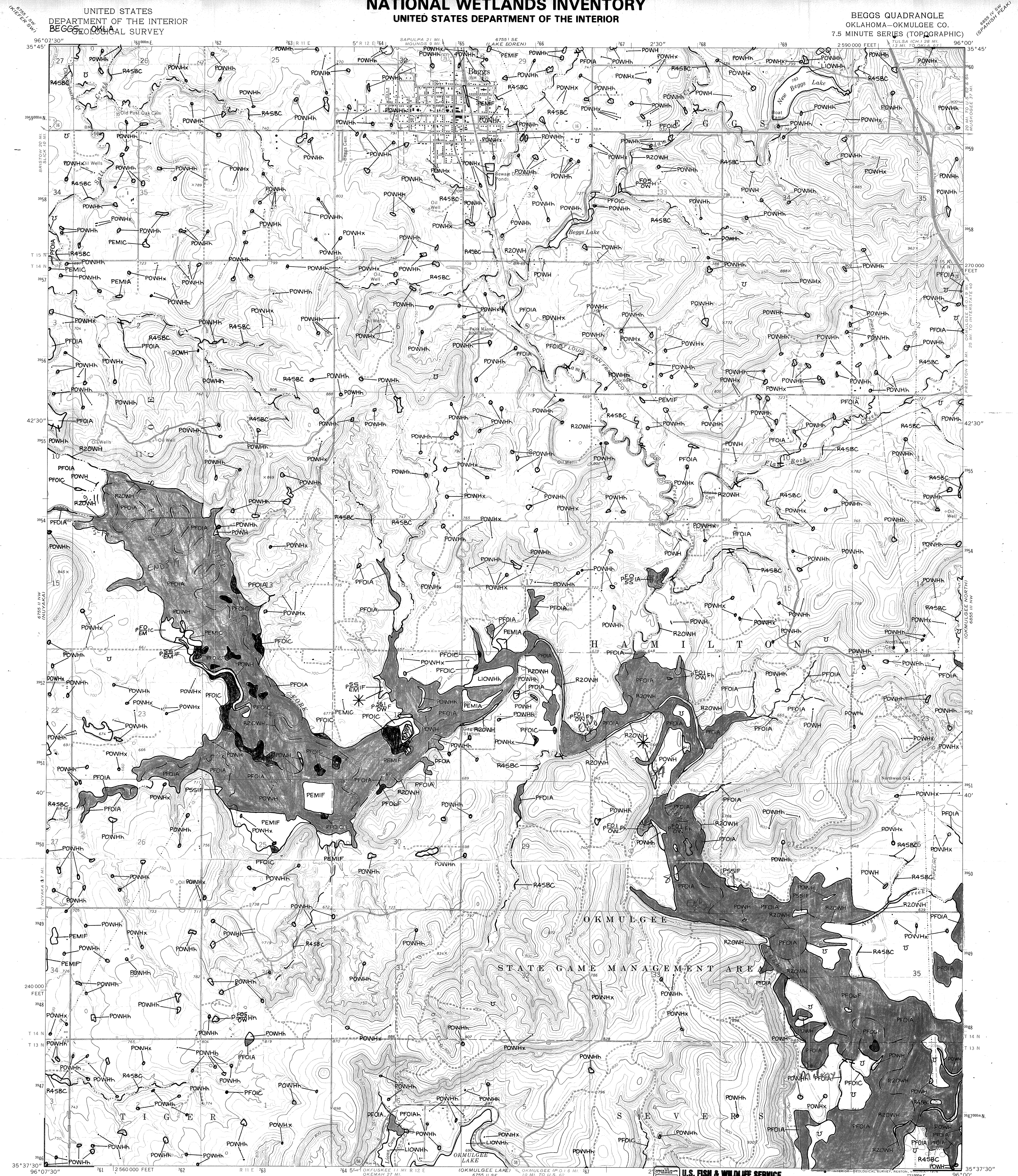

SPECIAL NOTE

This document was prepared primarily by stereoscopic analysis of high altitude aerial photographs. Wetlands were identified on the photographs based on vegetation, visible hydrology, and geography in accordance with Classification of Wetlands and Deep-Water Habitats of the United States (An Operational Draft). Coverages are listed below. Aerial photographs typically cover a 70% overlap between specific year and season when they were taken. In addition, there is a margin of error inherent in the use of the aerial photographs. The National Wetlands Inventory is a historical analysis of a single site may result in a revision of the wetland boundaries established through photographic interpretation. In addition, some small wetlands and those obscured by dense forest cover may not be included on this document.

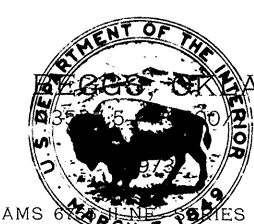
