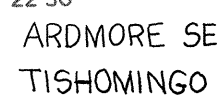

This document was prepared primarily by stereoscopic analysis of high altitude aerial photographs. Wetlands were identified on the photographs and the results were summarized by the Biology and Conservation Division in accordance with **Classification of Wetlands and Deepwater Habitats of the United States (FWS OBS - 79/31 December 1979)**. The aerial photographs were taken during the summer of 1979, during the year and season when they were taken. In addition, there is a margin of error inherent in the use of the aerial photographs. Aerial photographs are a two dimensional analysis of a single site may result in a revision of the wetland boundaries established through photographic interpretation. In addition, some small wetlands and those in heavily forested areas may not be included on this document.

Federal, State and local regulatory agencies with jurisdiction over the wetlands of the United States may use this document in a different manner than that used in this inventory.
