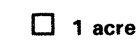

This document was prepared primarily by stereoscopic analysis of high altitude aerial photographs. Wetlands were identified by the use of stereoscopic techniques, and hydrology, and geography in accordance with **Classification of Wetlands and Deepwater Habitats of the United States**. The aerial photographs used in this report were taken during the specific year and season when they were taken. In addition, there is a margin of error inherent in the use of aerial photographs. Aerial photographs of the ground and historical analysis of a single site may result in a revision of the wetland boundaries established through photographic analysis. Wetland boundaries may be obscured or obscured by dense forest cover may not be included on this document.

Federal, State and local regulatory agencies with jurisdiction over wetlands may define and describe wetlands in a different manner than that used in this inventory. There is no attempt, in either the design or products of this inventory, to establish a standard for wetland identification by any Federal, State or local government or to establish the geographical scope of the regulatory programs of government agencies. Persons involved in the design or production of any Federal, State or local inventory should be aware that wetland areas should seek the advice of appropriate Federal, State or local agencies concerning specified agency regulatory programs and proprietary jurisdictions that may exist in such activities.

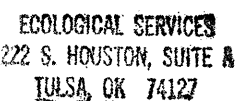
