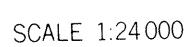

This document was prepared primarily by stereoscopic analysis of high altitude aerial photographs. The resulting identification of the boundaries of the vegetation types is based on the use of aerial photography and is subject to the variability of photography and geography in accordance with **Classification of Wetlands and Deepwater Habitats of the United States** (FWS/OBS - 79/31 (December 1979)). The aerial photographs typically reflect conditions existing during the year of aerial photography and are subject to the variability of the aerial photography and the variability of the terrain. In addition, there is a margin of error inherent in the use of the aerial photographs. Thus, a detailed on the ground and historical analysis of a single site may result in a revision of the interpretation of the boundaries established through the aerial interpretation. In addition, the boundaries established through the aerial interpretation may vary from the boundaries established on the ground by dense forest cover may not be included on this document.

 - On earlier NWI maps that class was designated Beach/Bar (BB), or Flat (FL). Subclasses remain the same in both versions.
