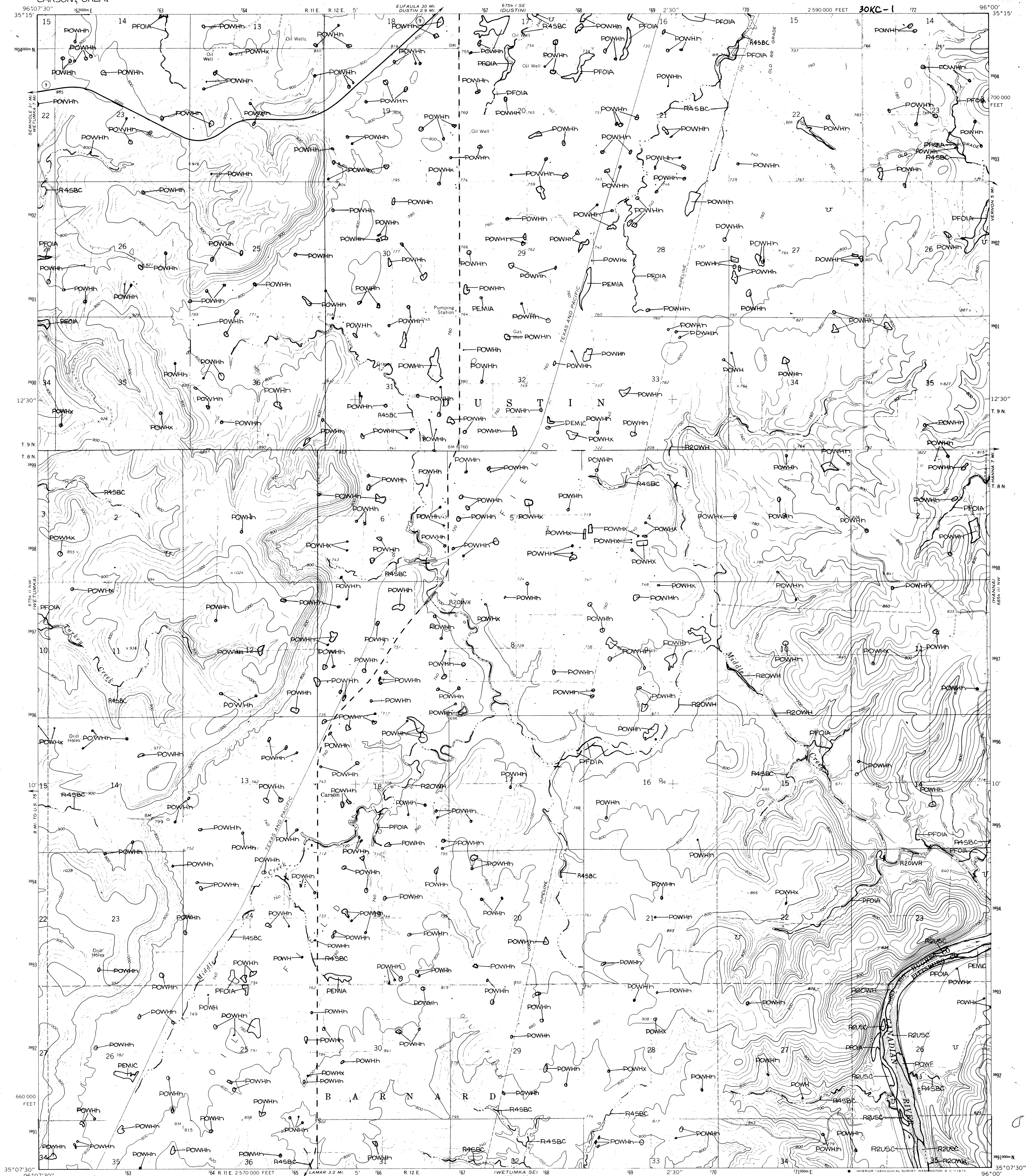

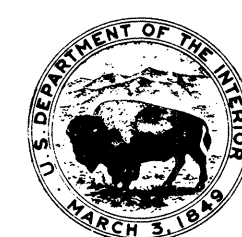

SPECIAL NOTE

SPECIAL NOTE This analysis was prepared primarily by stereoscopic analysis of high altitude aerial photographs. Wetlands were identified on the photographs based on vegetation, visible hydrology, and geography in accordance with **Classification of Wetlands and Deepwater Habitats** (National Wetlands Inventory, United States (An Operational Draft), Cowardin, et al, 1977). The aerial photographs typically reflect conditions during the specific year and season when they were taken. In addition, there is a margin of error associated with the use of aerial photography. The data obtained from a detailed on the ground and historical analysis of a single site may result in a revision of the wetland boundaries established through photographic interpretation. In addition, some small, isolated wetlands and areas of dense forest cover may not be included in this document.

Federal, State and local regulatory agencies with jurisdiction over wetlands may define and describe wetlands in a different manner than that used in this inventory. There is no attempt, in either the design or products of this inventory, to define the limits of proprietary jurisdiction of any Federal, State or local government or to establish the geographical scope of the regulatory programs of government agencies.
