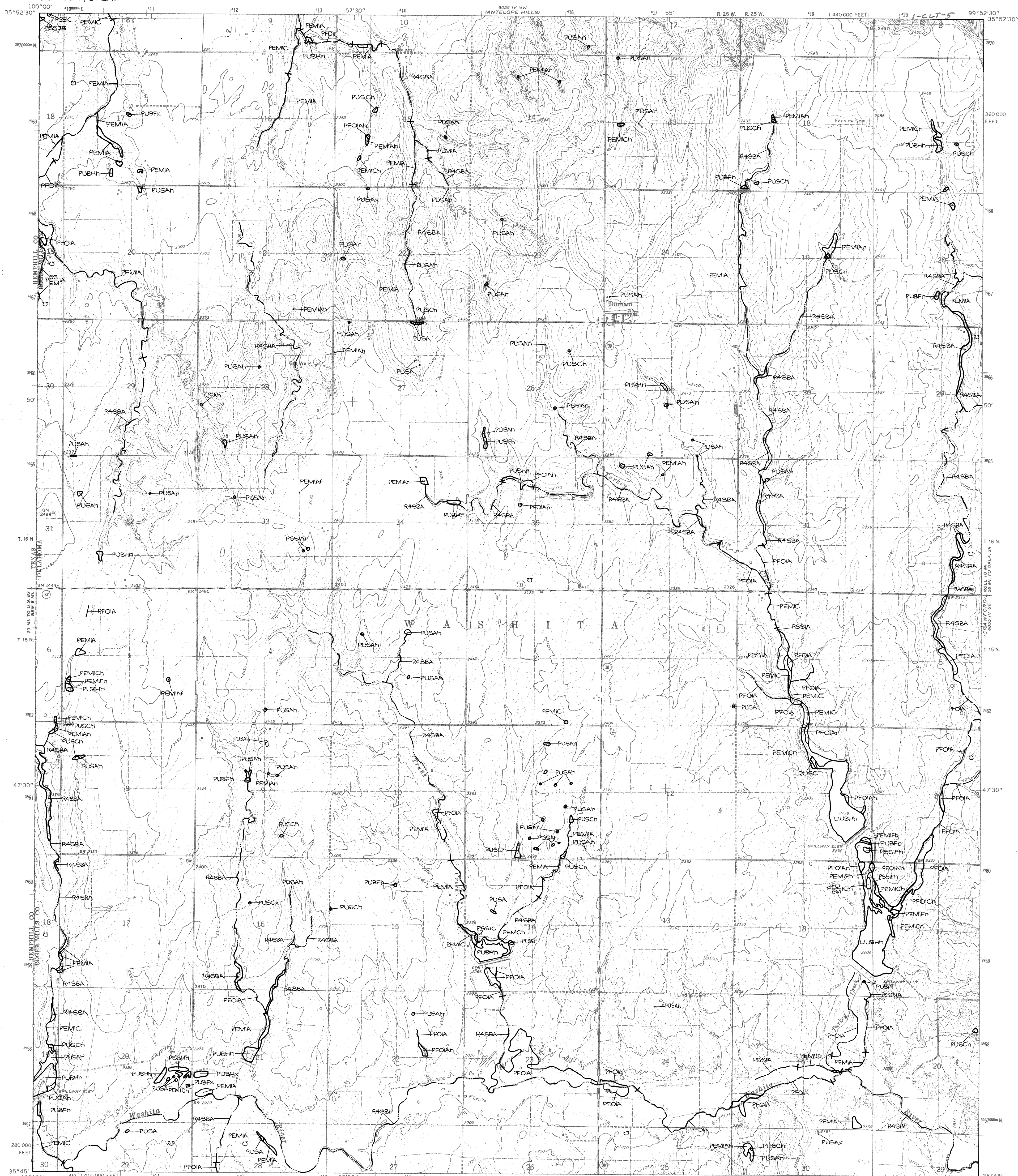


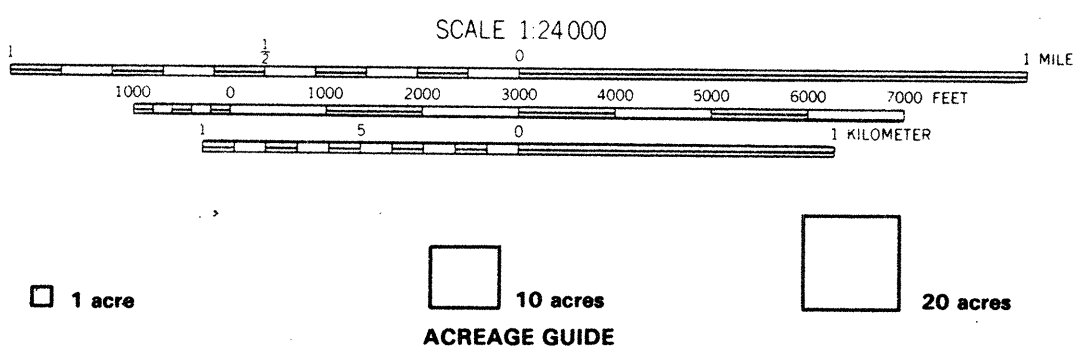

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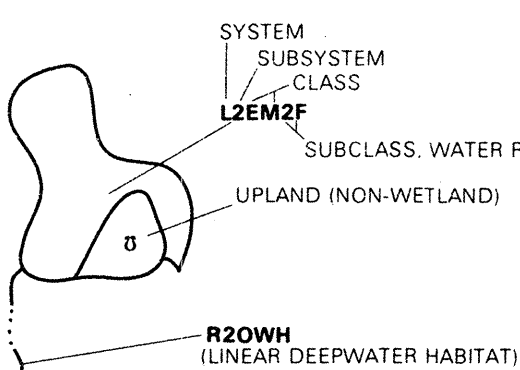


SPECIAL NOTE

This document was prepared primarily by stereoscopic analysis of high altitude aerial photographs. Wetlands were identified on the photographs based on vegetation, visible hydrology, and geography in accordance with Classification Systems (FWS/OBS - 79/31 December 1979). The aerial photographs typically reflect conditions during the specific year and season when they were taken. In addition, there are numerous limitations to the use of aerial photographs. Thus, a detailed on the ground and historical analysis of a single site may result in a revision of the wetland boundaries established through photographic interpretation. In addition, some small wetlands and those with sparse forest cover may not be included on this document.

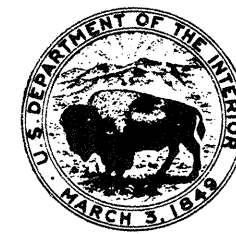

- Some areas designated as RASB or RASBW, OR RASBJ or RASBJI (INTERMITTENT STREAMS) may not meet the definition of wetland.
- This map uses the class Unconsolidated Shore (US).
- On earlier NWI maps that class was designated Beach/Bar (B) or Flat (FL). Subclasses remain the same in both versions.
