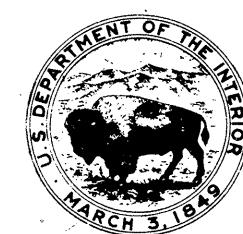


NATIONAL WETLANDS INVENTORY
