SPECIAL NOTE

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This document was prepared primarily by stereoscopic analysis of high altitude aerial photographs. Wetlands were identified from the photographs based on vegetation, visible hydrology, and other features. The study was conducted in the **Wetlands and Deep-Water Habitats of the United States (An Operational Draft)**, Cowardin, et al, 1977. The study was conducted during the summer of 1977, during a specific year and season when they were taken. In addition, there is a margin of error inherent in the use of the stereoscopic method. The use of the stereoscopic method in historical analysis of a single site may result in a revision of the wetland boundaries established through photographic analysis. Wetland boundaries may be obscured or obscured by dense forest cover may not be included on this document.

The State and local regulatory agencies with jurisdiction over wetlands may define and describe wetlands in a different manner than that used in this inventory. There is no attempt, in either the design or products of this inventory, to suggest that the State and local regulatory agencies, Federal, State or local government or to establish the geographical scope of the regulatory programs of government.
