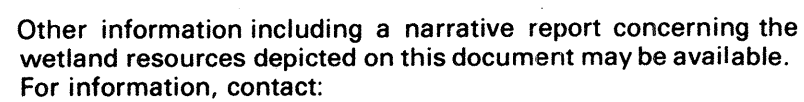

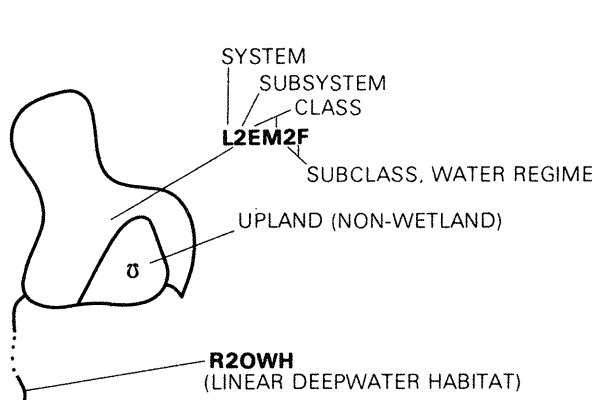
SPECIAL NOTE
