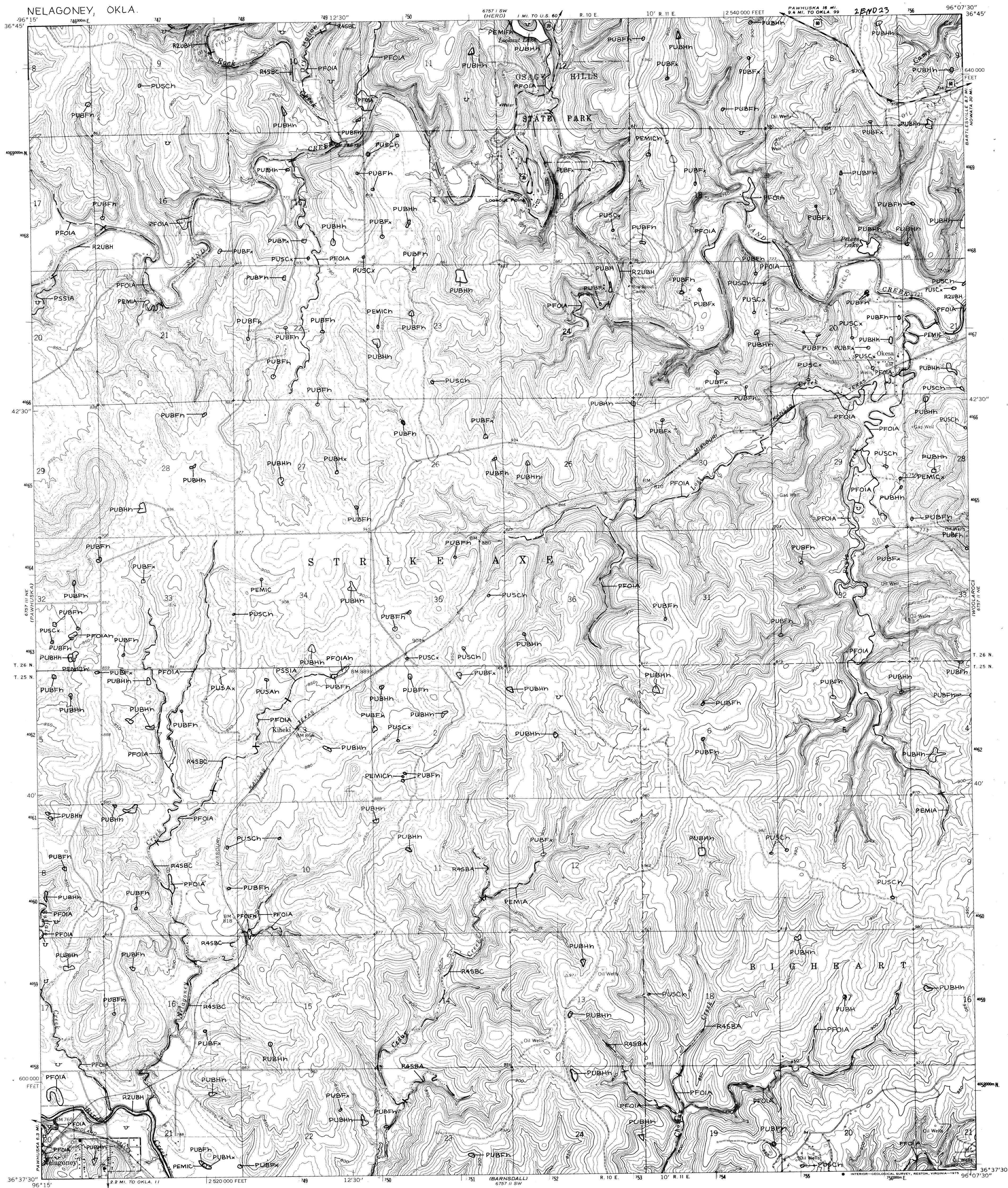


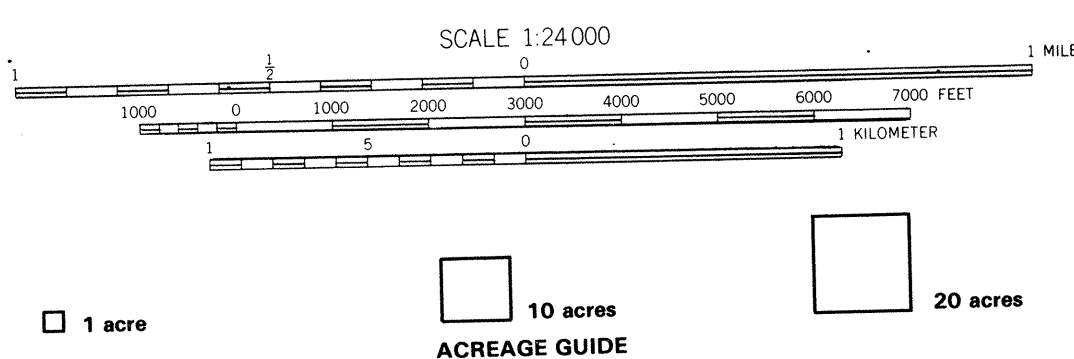

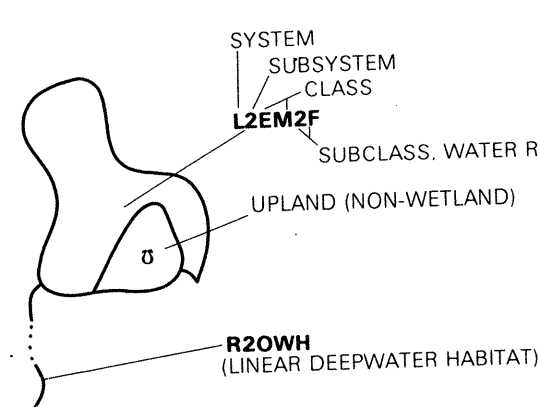

SPECIAL NOTE

SPECIAL TECHNIQUES was prepared primarily by stereoscopic analysis of high altitude aerial photographs. Wetlands were identified on the photographs based on the visible characteristics of the terrain. The manual was developed with **Classification of Wetlands and Deepwater Habitats of the United States (FWS/OBS - 79/31 December 1978)** as the basis for the specific photographic interpretation. The photographs were taken during the spring and summer season when they were taken. In addition, there is a margin of error inherent in the use of the aerial photographs, namely, a detailed on the ground investigation of a single site may result in a revision of the wetland boundaries established through photographic interpretation. In addition, some riparian cover may not be included on this document.

Federal, State and local regulatory agencies with jurisdiction over wetlands are to use and describe wetlands in a different manner than that used in this inventory. There is no attempt, in either the design or products of this inventory, to provide a uniform description of wetlands. Therefore, Federal, State or local government or to establish the geographical scope of the regulatory programs of government agencies. The inventory is intended to provide activities areas should seek the advice of appropriate Federal, State or local agencies for the purpose of determining the regulatory and proprietary jurisdictions that may affect such activities.

 - This map uses the class Unconsolidated Shore (US).
 - On earlier NWI maps that class was designated Beach/Bar (BB), or Flat (FL). Subclasses remain the same in both versions.
