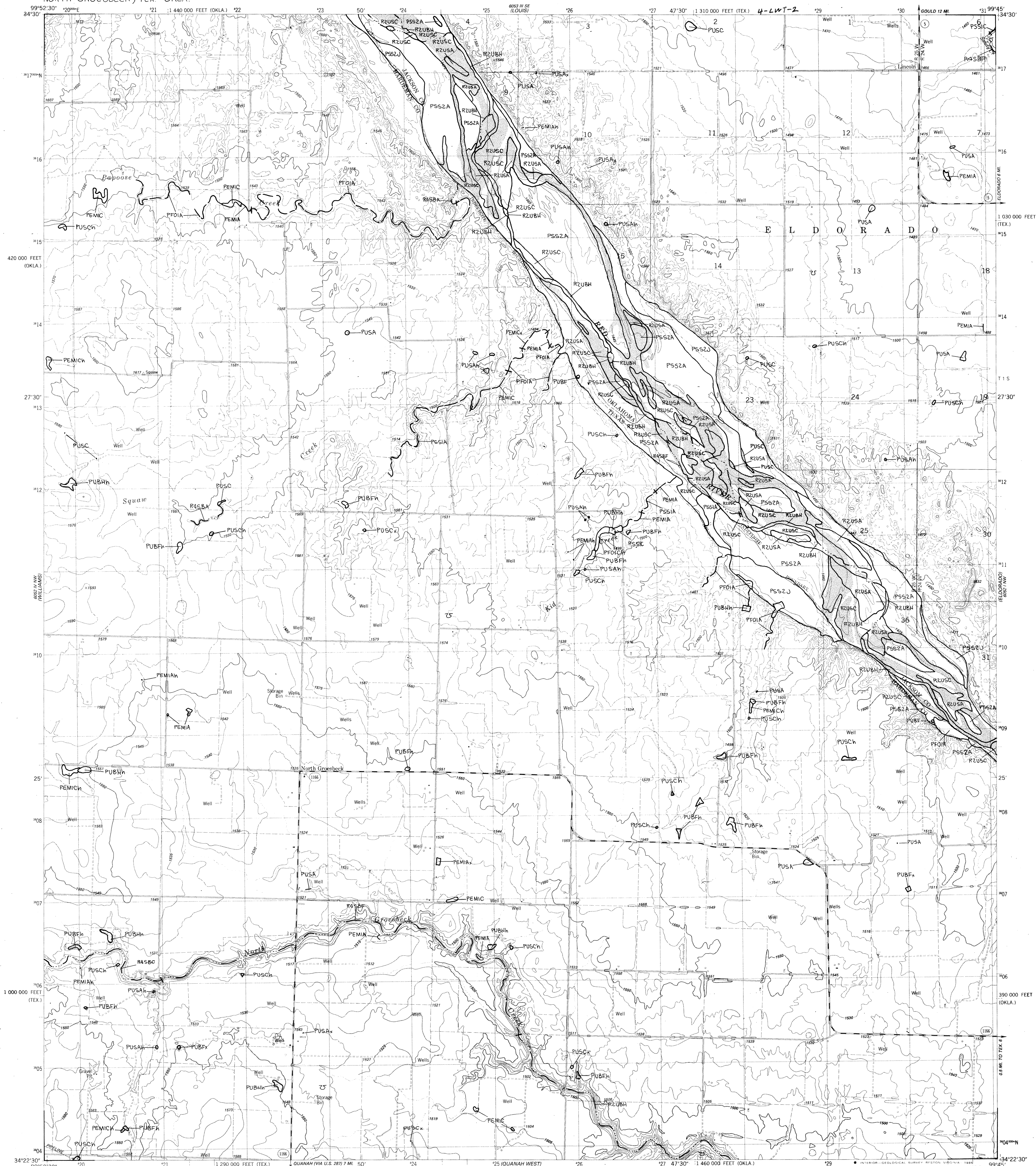

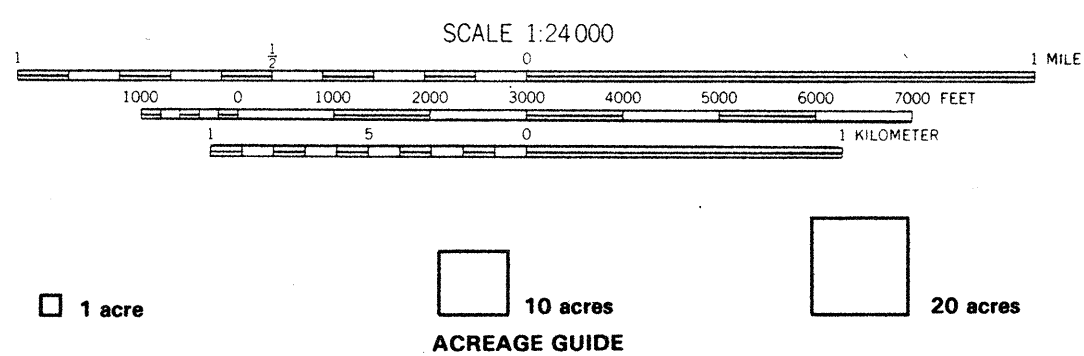

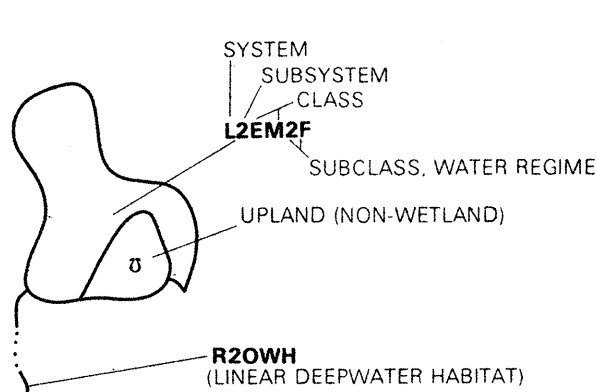


SPECIAL NOTE

This document was prepared primarily by stereoscopic analysis of high altitude aerial photographs. Wetlands were identified using the criteria of the National Wetlands Inventory (NWI) and were mapped using the criteria of the National Wetlands Inventory (NWI) hydrology, and geography in accordance with *Classification of Wetlands and Deepwater Habitats of the United States* (FWS/OBS - 79/31 December 1979). The aerial photographs typically reflect conditions during the specific year aerial photography was taken. The accuracy of the map is within a margin of error inherent in the use of the aerial photographs. Thus, a detail on the ground and historical analysis of a single site may result in a revision of the wetland boundaries established through photographic interpretation. In addition, small wetland areas, not observed by dense forest cover may not be included on this document.

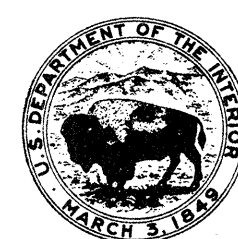
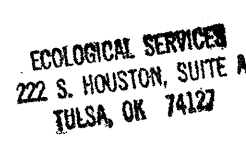

- Some areas designated as RASB, R4SBW, OR R4SBJ (INTERMITTENT STREAMS) may not meet the definition of wetland.
- This map uses the class Unconsolidated Shore (US), or the class HWI (crops that class was designated Beach/Bar (BB), or Flat (FL). Subclasses remain the same in both versions.
