

Wetlands were identified on the photographs based on vegetation, hydrology, and geography in accordance with Classification of Wetlands and Deep-Water Habitats of the United States (An Operational Draft). Cowardin et al. 1979. The aerial photographs were taken during the summer of 1979. Specific year and season when they were taken are indicated on the map. There is a margin of error in the use of these maps and symbols. Some areas designated R4SB, R4SBW, or R4SBJ (intermittent streams) may not meet the definition of wetlands.
