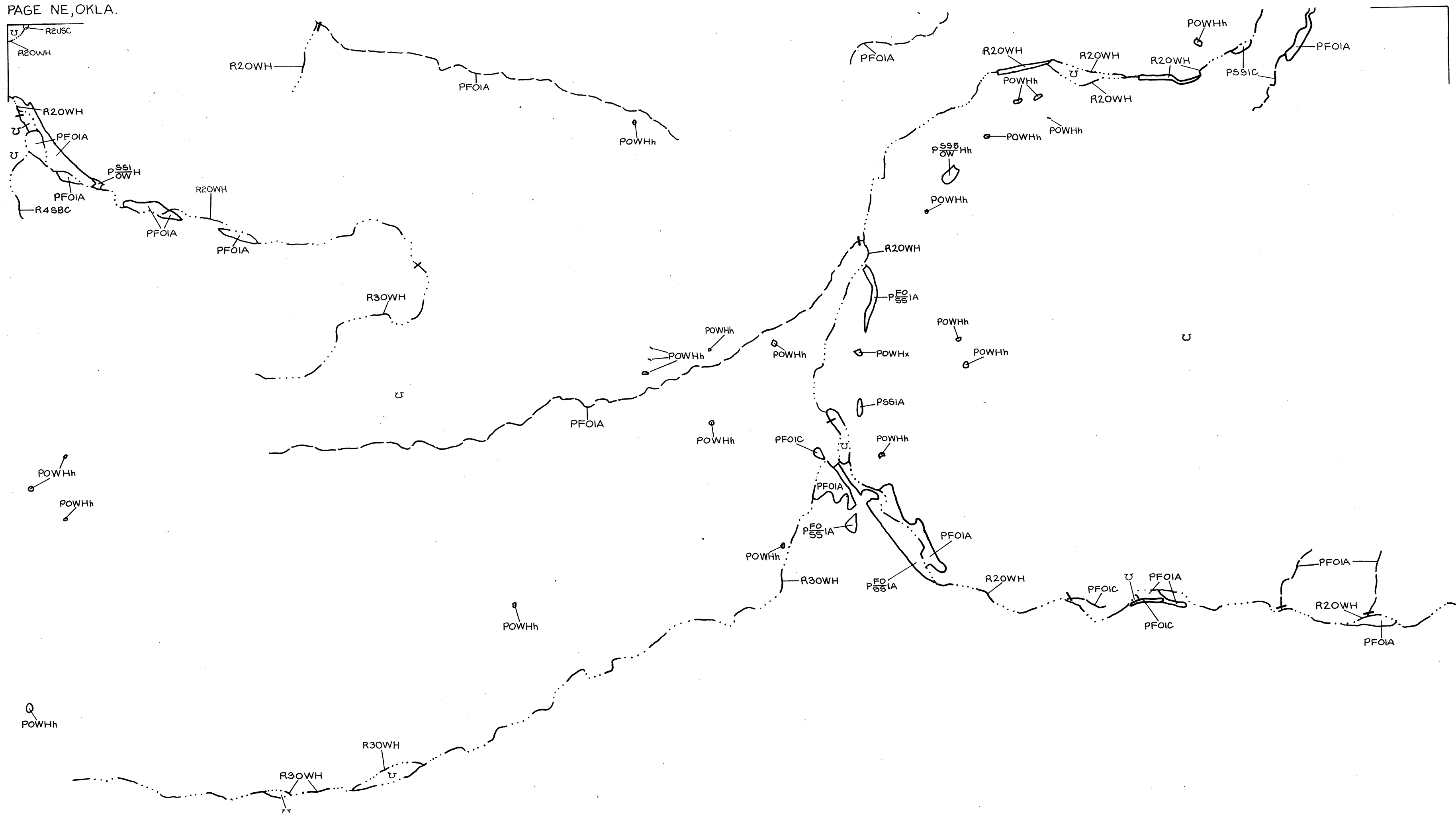

This document was prepared primarily by stereoscopic analysis of high altitude aerial photographs. Wetlands were identified on the photographs according to the procedures outlined in the manual titled "Aerial Photograph Interpretation of Wetlands and Deep-Water Habitats of the United States" (An Operational Draft), Cowardin, et al., 1970. The aerial photograph interpretation was done during the summer of 1968, one year and a season when they were taken. In addition, there is a margin of error inherent in the use of the aerial photographs. Thus, a site may result in a revision of the wetland boundaries established through photographic interpretation. In addition, some small wetlands and those obscured by dense forest cover may not be included on the map.

Federal, State and local regulatory agencies with jurisdiction over wetlands may define and describe wetlands in different manners than the criteria used in this inventory. It is important, either in the design or products of this inventory, to define the limits of proprietary jurisdiction of any Federal, State or local government agency or groups of government.
