

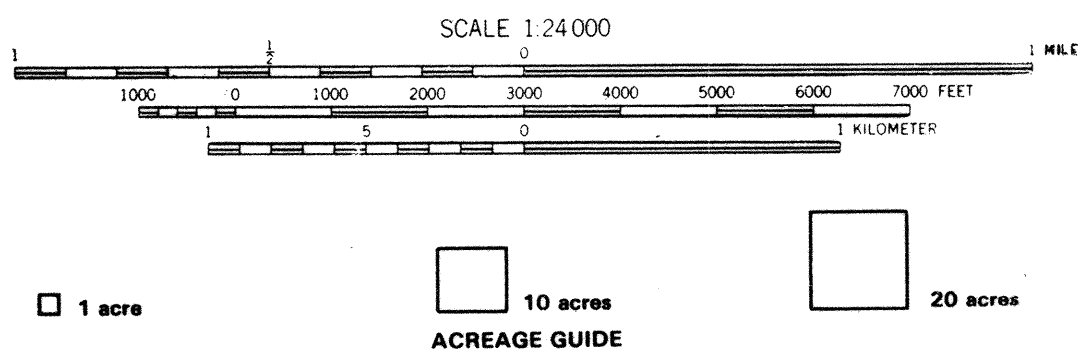

SPECIAL NOTE

This document was prepared primarily by stereoscopic analysis of high altitude aerial photographs. Wetland identification on the photographs was based on the color, texture, and geometry and geography in accordance with *Classification of Wetlands and Deepwater Habitats of the United States* (FWS/OBS - 79/31 December 1979). The aerial photographs typically reflect conditions during the specific year of photography. The use of aerial photography has a margin of error inherent in the use of the aerial photographs. Thus, a detailed on the ground and historical analysis of a single site may result in a revision of the wetland boundaries established through the interpretation of the aerial photographs. Small wetlands and those obscured by dense forest cover may not be included on this document.

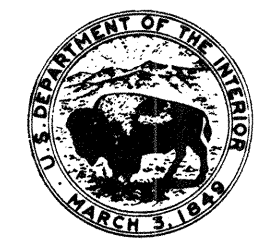

- On earlier NWI maps that class was designated Beach/Bar/Sand, or Flat (L). Subclasses remain the same in both versions.
