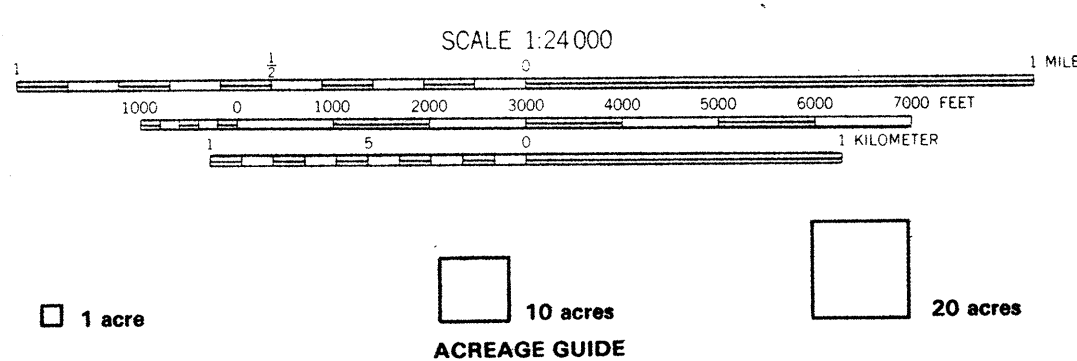

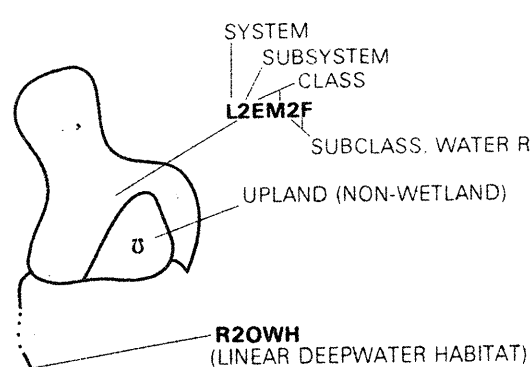

SPECIAL NOTE

This document was prepared primarily by stereoscopic analysis of high altitude aerial photographs. Wetlands were identified on the photographs based on vegetation patterns. The results of this analysis are presented in the map with Classification of Wetlands and Deepwater Habitats of the United States (FWS/OBS-79/31 December 1979). The aerial photographs used were taken during the summer of 1978 and the year and season when they were taken. In addition, there is a margin of error inherent in the use of the aerial photographs, and a small error in the map may result. In addition, a small error may result in a revision of the wetland boundaries established through photographic interpretation. In addition, some small wetlands and those in the forest cover may not be included on this document.

Federal, State and local regulatory agencies with jurisdiction over the wetlands should be consulted to determine the manner that should be used in this inventory. There is no overlap, in either the design or products of this inventory, to define the limits of proprietary jurisdiction of any agency. The map is intended to be used in the geographical scope of the regulatory programs of government agencies. Persons intending to engage in activities in the wetlands should consult the appropriate Federal, State or local agencies concerning specific agency regulatory programs and proprietary jurisdictions that may affect the wetlands.

- Subsystems, Classes, Subclasses, and Water Regimes in *atlantis* were developed specifically for NATIONAL WETLANDS INVENTORY mapping.
- Some classes designated as RASB, R4SBW, OR R4SBJ (INTERMITTENT STREAMS) may not meet the definition of wetland.
- This map uses the class Unconsolidated Shore (US). On earlier NWI maps that class was designated Beach/Bar (BB), or Flat (FL). Subclasses remain the same in both versions.
