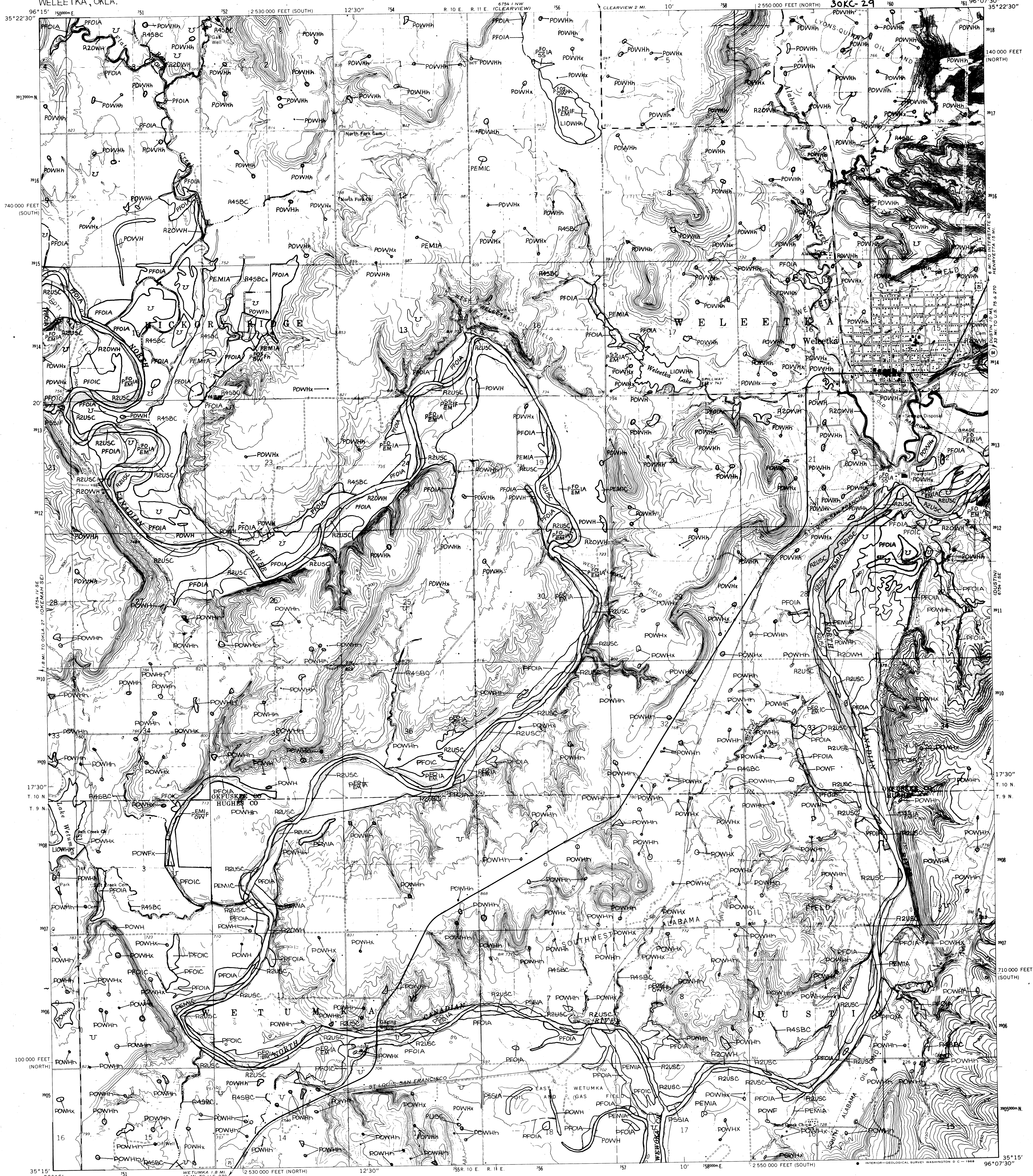

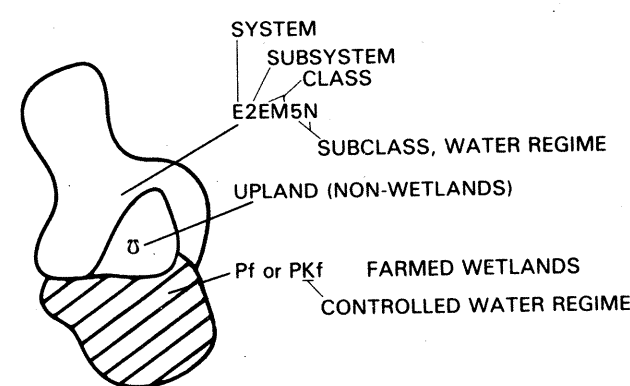

SPECIAL NOTE

This document was prepared primarily by stereoscopic analysis of high altitude aerial photographs. Wetlands were identified on the photographs based on vegetation patterns. The results of this analysis are presented in the *Classification of Wetlands and Deep-Water Habitats of the United States* (An Operational Draft), Cowardin, et al. 1977. The aerial photographs typically reflect conditions during the specific year and season when they were taken. Therefore, the results of the analysis may not be representative of the use of the wetland photographs. Thus, a detailed on the ground and historical analysis of a single site may result in a revision of the wetland boundaries established through photographic interpretation. In addition, some small wetlands and the forested wetlands may be obscured by dense forest cover may not be included on the map.

Federal, State and local regulatory agencies with jurisdiction over wetlands may define and describe wetlands in a different manner than that used in this inventory. There is no attempt, in either the design or products of this inventory, to define the limits of proprietary jurisdiction of any Federal, State or local government or to establish the geographical scope of the regulatory programs of government agencies.
