The first and last paragraph of each letter was the same, and in between, Protestants filled in a list of identical, generic reasons, offered separately by a third-party (e.g., “Recreation/Hunting/Fishing,” “Endangered Species,” “Loss of Water for Drinking/Rural and City”). *See, e.g.*, Marcia Self’s protest letter (demonstrating the original template with few personal edits).
2. Form Letter B – Protestants submitted letters that were nearly identical.
3. Form Letter C – Protestants submitted letters that were nearly identical.
4. Form Letter D – Protestants submitted letters that were nearly identical.
5. Form Letter E – Protestants submitted letters that were nearly identical.
6. Form Letter F – Protestant counties submitted letters that were nearly identical.
