On behalf of BCM Oklahoma, LLC (BCM), please let this letter serve as the 2013 4th Quarter report for the Davis Quarry in Murray County. The report was designed to fulfill the reporting requirement specified by 82 O.S. §1020.2. The quarterly report has been simplified based on discussions with your staff.

The quarterly data summarized in table below was collected following BCM's Quarry Water Monitoring Plan. Review of available data indicates that there is no overt indication of *pit water* (i.e., ground water) contribution, and therefore, no consumptive use. Please note that this information is considered preliminary, draft and subject to internal correction, modification, and/or change.
