

Please let this letter serve as the 2017 1st Quarterly Monitoring Report for the Washita Quarry in Murray County. This site, formerly known as the BCM Rogers/Chambless (Davis) Quarry, came under control of Martin Marietta/Material Producers effective January 16, 2015. This letter is designed to fulfill the reporting requirements specified by 82 O.S. 1020.2.
