Dear Mrs. Jenkins:

Your application to amend stream water right 2024-005 has been reviewed by Board staff. In order to obtain a permit, you must provide notice of the essential facts about your intended use by newspaper publication.

In accordance with 82 O.S. 2001, Sec. 105.11, as amended, we have enclosed Notices of Publication to be published at your expense in newspapers qualified to publish legal notices in the county of your point of diversion, Kay County, and the adjacent downstream county, Osage County. The notice must appear in the newspapers once a week for the two consecutive weeks beginning on August 24, 2025 and August 31, 2025. Please send us or have the publishers forward the copy of the Certified Proof of Publications within fifteen (15) days after the last publication date. In addition to notice by publication, a recent decision of the Oklahoma Supreme Court now also requires the enclosed Notices of Application be provided to "known or easily discoverable landowner[s]" who may be directly affected by your application to use stream water. Purcell v. Parker, 2020 OK 83. Once notice has been provided to affected landowners, proof of the same must be supplied to the Board within fifteen (15) days. Because the Board is not responsible for the form, content or accuracy of the enclosed notices, please review the notices and contact this office if you note any errors.

If your application is protested, we will notify you and schedule a hearing. If you have any questions concerning this matter, please contact Sharon Robinson at the address below or call (405) 530-8800.

## NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO AMEND EXISTING USE OF STREAM WATER

Notice is hereby given that Kaw Nation c/o Kimberly Jenkins whose address is 698 Grandview Drive, Kaw City, OK 74641 has filed a petition to amend Term Stream Water Permit #2024-005, with the Oklahoma Water Resources Board (Board). The application asks to add a second diversion point on Kaw Lake in the SE NW SE\* of Section 4, T26N, R4EIM, Kay County. Also, adding an additional 10 acres\* area of use to this amendment and are in the SE NE\* of Section 4 T26N, R4EIM, Kay County. This will bring the total acres to 22.\* The term 5-year permit authorizes the withdrawal of up to 17.22 acre-feet per year not to exceed 300 gallons per minute for the use of irrigation. All other aspects of the water right will remain the same, as more specifically described in the application, viewable at oklahoma.gov/owrb. Use of stream water is governed by Sections 105.1 and following of Title 82 of the Oklahoma Statutes and rules of the Board, Oklahoma Administrative Code (OAC), Title 785, Chapter 20.

Protests to the application must be in writing and received by the Board at the address listed below and by the applicant at the address listed above no later than September 29, 2025, and contain the following: (1) name, address, and telephone number of the interested person; (2) the particular application number to which the protest relates; (3) specific information to show how approval of the application proposed may directly and adversely affect legally protected interests of the person filing the protest; and (4) a statement of the relief sought by the interested person. A person who sends a letter containing only a general objection or comment will not be deemed to be a party, but the letter will be made part of the permanent record.

If a protest that meets the requirements listed in the paragraph above is filed with both the applicant and Board, a hearing on this application will be scheduled and the applicant and protestant(s) will be advised of the hearing date. Protestants or their representatives must appear at the hearing and present the protest to be considered. Hearings are governed by Section 309 of Title 75 and Section 105.11 of Title 82 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and the rules of Board, OAC Title 785, chapters 4 and 20. 

#### 11. SUBMISSION AND PROCESSING

The submitted application packet must include the following:

- a. Original completed application (Typed or printed in ink, with legible markings, signed and notarized.);
- **b. Filing fee payment** (Review of the application will not begin until the filing fee is received. Filing fees are refunded at the discretion of the OWRB. Preferred payment method is a check payable to the OWRB. Other payment methods include cash, money order, or credit card via the OWRB Website Pay Portal please provide a copy of the Pay Portal receipt. If water is used before application approval, double the filing fee will be required.);
- c. Ownership documents (Copies of deeds, leases, easements, rights-of-access, and/or other letters of consent for all the land owned/controlled by the applicant associated with the application. Tax documents are not accepted. Social security numbers are not required and should be marked out on documents that contain them.)
- d. Any other documentation requested by OWRB staff as necessary (Articles of organization or incorporation, memorandum of trust, license or registration from OMMA or ODAFF, contract for water sales, etc.).

### Please note: Any incomplete or unresponsive answers may cause a delay in the processing of your application.

All stream water permits issued by the Board contain a condition and limitation that the use of stream water shall not interfere with domestic uses or existing appropriative rights. If the full amount of water is not able to be used within the first seven (7) years after permit approval, please contact Board staff to discuss possible options, such as submitting a schedule of use. In addition, Oklahoma Administrative Code (OAC) 785:20-3-9 states: (a) "Upon filing of an application that is defective as to form or unsatisfactory as to feasibility or safety of the plan or as to the showing of the ability of the applicant to carry the construction to completion, the Board shall advise applicant of the correction, amendments, or changes required, and sixty (60) days from the date the Board so advises shall be allowed for the filing thereof. [82:105.10]" (b) "Any corrected application filed after the time allowed in (a) of this Section shall be treated in all respects as a new application on the date of its refiling [82:105.10] and the original priority date of filing shall be lost." (c) "If an applicant does not correct an application or publish notice as instructed by the Board, and no further proceedings are initiated by the applicant for six months or more after last contact with the Board, the application shall be deemed withdrawn. The Board shall provide notice to the applicant that the application has been deemed withdrawn."
