Your application to use groundwater has been reviewed by Board staff. In order to obtain a permit, you must provide notice of the essential facts about your intended use by newspaper publication and by notifying certain neighbors.

In accordance with Section 309 of Title 75 and Section 1020.8 of Title 82 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and Section 785:30-3-4 of the Oklahoma Administrative Code (OAC), we have enclosed a Notice of Application to be published at your expense in a newspaper that is qualified to publish legal notices in Carter County. The notice must be published once a week for the two consecutive weeks beginning on June 21, 2026 and June 28, 2026. Please send us, or have the publisher forward to us, the certified proofs of publication by July 20, 2026. Because the Board is not responsible for the accuracy of the information contained in the notice, please review the enclosed notice carefully and contact the Board if you note any errors or have any questions.

In addition to giving notice by publication of your application to withdraw groundwater, OAC Section 785:30-3-4(a) requires that you notify by certified mail (return receipt requested) all surface estate owners of lands located within 1,320 feet of the outside boundary of each ten-acre tract regarding wells subject to your application. Please notify these landowners on or before the first day of publication. We have enclosed extra copies of the notice for this purpose. You may make additional copies if you need more than we have provided. Also enclosed is an affidavit certifying you have notified all of these surface estate owners. The affidavit must be signed, notarized, and returned to the Board, along with all green cards, by or before July 20, 2026.

Any protests to your application must be filed with the Board by July 27, 2026. If a protest is filed, a hearing may be scheduled and you will be notified.

NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO USE GROUNDWATER

City of Wilson c/o Frank Schaaf of 1065 US HWY 70A, Wilson, OK 73462 has filed an application, #2025-631, with the Oklahoma Water Resources Board (Board) for a permit to use 1,010 acre-feet of groundwater per year. The groundwater is proposed to be used for municipal water supply and taken from 505 acres located as follows: 8 acres in the S2 SE NE, 17 acres in the W2 W2 NE, 20 acres in the E2 E2 NW, 21 acres in the E2 E2 SW, 160 acres in the SE of Section 32, T4S; 10 acres in the SW SW NW, 13 acres in the W2 NE NW, 92 acres in the SW of Section 33, T4S; 10 acres in the NE NE NW, 56 acres in the S2 NW, 97 acres in the NE of Section 5, and 1 acre in the N2 NE NE of Section 6, T5S; all in R2WIM, Carter County. The water is to be withdrawn from four (4) wells located as follows: one (1) well each in the NE SE SE, SE SE SE, and NE SW SE of Section 32, T4S; one (1) well in the N2 NE NE of Section 6, T5S; all in R2WIM, Carter County, and use the groundwater in Carter County, Oklahoma, as more specifically described in the application, viewable at oklahoma.gov/owrb. Wells and dedicated lands are located over an Undetermined Bedrock groundwater basin, which consists of but is not limited to the Garber Sandstone, Wellington Formation, and/or Stillwater Formations. Board rules require that the well be located a distance of at least 1,320 feet from existing wells or proposed well locations on lands of another unless a well location exception is granted. The applicant will be asking for a well location exception. If no objection is received from any landowners having a well located within 1,320 feet of the wells requested to be authorized, the exception may be granted. Use of groundwater is governed by Sections 1020.1 and following of Title 82 of the Oklahoma Statutes and rules of the Board, Oklahoma Administrative Code, Title 785, Chapters 4 and 30.

Protests to the application must be in writing and received by the Board at the address listed below and by the applicant at the address listed above no later than July 27, 2026, and contain the following: (1) name, address, and telephone number of the interested person; (2) the particular application number to which the protest relates; (3) specific information to show how approval of the application proposed may directly and adversely affect legally protected interests of the person filing the protest; and (4) a statement of the relief sought by the interested person. A person who sends a letter containing only a general objection or comment will not be deemed to be a party, but the letter will be made part of the permanent record.

If a protest that meets the requirements listed in the paragraph above is filed with both the applicant and Board, a hearing on this application will be scheduled and the applicant and protestant(s) will be advised of the hearing date. Protestants or their representatives must appear at the hearing and present the protest to be considered. Hearings are governed by Section 309 of Title 75 and Section 1020.8 of Title 82 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and the rules of Board, OAC Title 785, chapters 4 and 30.
