Johnson Family Farms, LLC of 9434 N. 2090 Road, Butler, OK 73625 has filed an application, #2025-633, with the Oklahoma Water Resources Board (Board) for a permit to use 2,105.5 acre-feet of groundwater per year. The groundwater is proposed to be used for irrigation (alfalfa, wheat, and milo) and commercial sale for oil and gas and taken from 1,052.75 acres located as follows: 160 acres in the SW of Section 8, T13N, R18WIM; 88 acres in the NW and 158.75 acres in the NE of Section 5, T13N, R19ECM; 55 acres in the S2 NW and 145 acres in the E2 of Section 31, 51 acres in the W2 NW and 320 acres in the S2 of Section 32, T14N, R19WIM; 75 acres in the SE of Section 36, T14N, R20WIM; all in Custer County. The water is to be withdrawn from four (4) wells located as follows: one (1) well in the SW SE NW of Section 5, T13N, R19WIM; one (1) well each in the SW NE SE, NW SE SE, SE SE SE of Section 36, T14N, R20WIM; all in Custer County, and use the groundwater in Custer County, Oklahoma, as more specifically described in the application, viewable at oklahoma.gov/owrb. Wells and dedicated lands are located over the Alluvium and Terrace of the Washita-Reach 1 groundwater basin. Board rules require that the well be located a distance of at least 660 feet from existing wells or proposed well locations on lands of another unless a well location exception is granted. Tax documents are not accepted. Social security numbers are not required and should be marked out on documents that contain them.)
- d. **Any other documentation requested by OWRB staff as necessary** (Articles of organization or incorporation, memorandum of trust, license or registration from OMMA or ODAFF, contract for water sales, etc.).
