

POST-HEARING ORDER ON NOTICE AND SCHEDULING

IN THE MATTER OF DETERMINING THE MAXIMUM ANNUAL YIELD FOR THE ARBUCKLE-SIMPSON GROUNDWATER BASIN

A hearing was held in the above-referenced matter on May 15 and 16, 2012, in Sulphur, Oklahoma. At the conclusion of the hearing, the parties requested clarification regarding service to one another during the post-hearing period. This Order addresses service and memorializes the briefing schedule (with one extension of time) and briefing requirements.

1. Service to Parties.


Any materials received by the OWRB shall be placed on its website as expeditiously as possible. In addition, those parties wishing to receive materials by email may provide an email address to the OWRB by 5 p.m. on May 24, 2012. The OWRB will compile a list of email addresses, which the OWRB will email to those listed therein for the parties' use in serving one another; however, this list will not be placed on the OWRB website. Parties that have not provided email addresses must be served by U.S. Mail. To facilitate service, the Hearing Examiner encourages those parties who prefer not to use email to designate a representative to receive email on their behalf. Any parties making such a designation shall notify the Oklahoma Water Resources Board (OWRB) and other parties no later than 5 p.m. on May 24, 2012.

2. Post-Hearing Briefing.

Parties may file post-hearing briefs. Initial briefs are due by 5:00 p.m. on May 31, 2012. Response briefs are due by 5:00 p.m. on June 14, 2012. Please note that the deadline for response briefs is later than that initially announced at the hearing to provide additional time to the parties. Initial briefs are limited to 40 pages and response briefs are limited to 25 pages. All briefs should be in Times New Roman 12-point type, double-spaced, with one-inch margins (including footnotes). Should a party wish to provide additional evidence with an initial brief, that party must also submit a motion to admit the evidence, which shall include a showing why that evidence could not have been provided during the hearing.
